14 New Cases of COVID-19 in Chautauqua County Today

We have received notification that a tenth Chautauqua County resident has died in an out of state hospital due to ongoing complications of COVID-19. This gentleman in his 50's was diagnosed in late July and has been hospitalized since. He suffered from multiple chronic health conditions and was not able to overcome complications of the infection. Our condolences go out to his loved ones.

Chautauqua County Statistics:

- 107 active cases, continue to recover under orders of the Local Health Official per NYS Public Health Law including:
 - 14 new cases today of :
 - two persons under the age of 18,
 - a female in her 20s,
 - two females in their 30s,
 - a male and two females in their 40s,
 - a male in his 50s,
 - a male and two females in their 60s,
 - a female in her 70s, and
 - a female in her 100s.
- 460 cases under quarantine/isolation orders by the Public Health Director and being monitored. Not all of those being monitored are confirmed to have COVID-19 but have either shown symptoms, are awaiting results, or have risk factors;
- 603 persons under domestic traveler quarantine for having arrived to Chautauqua County from a state listed on the New York State travel advisory;
- 2 person hospitalized* in Chautauqua County as of 8/27/2020
 - *number of persons in Chautauqua County hospitals diagnosed with COVID-19, regardless of residency
- To date:
 - 293 recovered cases;

- 10 deaths;
- 410 total confirmed cases; and
- 34,456 negative test results.
