No New Cases of COVID-19 in Chautauqua County Today

Chautauqua County statistics:

- 44 confirmed cases;
- 7 active cases - continue to recover under orders of the Local Health Official per NYS Public Health Law;
- 33 recovered cases;
- 4 deaths;
- 129 cases under quarantine/isolation orders by the Public Health Director and being monitored. Not all of those being monitored are confirmed to have COVID-19 but have either shown symptoms, are awaiting results, or have risk factors; and
- 1,628 negative test results to date.


Dear William,

Why wear a mask? Out of respect. When you wear a mask you are saying, I respect my neighbors. When you wear a mask you are saying, I respect nurses and doctors. When you wear a mask you are saying, I respect other people. We all need to show respect to one another in difficult times. Wearing a face covering is a small inconvenience to protect others. We have gotten through this crisis by standing together and doing

the right thing. The right thing — the respectful thing — is to wear a mask.

1. I am directing hospitals statewide to prioritize COVID-19 testing for children displaying symptoms of multi-system inflammatory syndrome. We are currently investigating approximately 100 reported cases in New York where children are experiencing a potentially COVID-related illness that has [serious symptoms](#). It's crucial that children hospitalized with these symptoms are tested for COVID-19.

2. Twelve Members of Congress will introduce the 'Americans First Law' to help prevent corporate bailouts following the COVID-19 pandemic. On Sunday, I proposed a new federal law that would forbid corporations from getting government bailouts if they don't rehire the same number of employees they had before the COVID-19 pandemic. Twelve Congresswomen and men from our great state [have agreed](#) to propose this law that puts workers first.
