REGULAR MEETING TOWN BOARD OF CHERRY CREEK

LOCATION: TOWN HALL, 6845 MAIN STREET, CHERRY CREEK, NY

PRESENT: William Young, James Abbey, Ryan Lepp, Bruce Hendricks, Matt West, Ken Chase, Jayson Rowicki and Mia Abbey.

William Young brought the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Bruce Hendricks, seconded by Ryan Lepp, all in favor to accept June 14, 2021 minutes.

SUPERVISOR/TREASURERS REPORT: Motion was made by Matt West and seconded Bruce Hendricks , all in favor to accept Supervisor/Treasurers Report, none opposed.

CLERKS REPORT: Motion was made by Ryan Lepp and seconded by Bruce Hendricks, all in favor to accept Clerks Report, none opposed.

GENERAL BILLS: #183-211 totaling \$ 8,733.88 motion was made by Ryan Lepp and seconded by Matt West, all in favor to pay General Bills, none opposed.

HIGHWAY BILLS: #82-#96 totaling \$63,453.25, motion was made by Bruce Hendricks and seconded by Ryan Lepp, all in favor to pay Highway bills, none opposed.

WATER BILLS: #43-#51 totaling \$^{2329.10}~~812~~, **SEWER BILLS:** #31-#31 TOTALING \$321.00 , motion was made by Matt West and seconded by Bruce Hendricks, all in favor to pay Water/Sewer bills, none opposed.

CODE/ASSESSORS REPORT: Motion was made by Ryan Lepp and seconded by Jim Abbey to accept the Code and Assessor Report. A total of 6 permits were issued totaling \$320.00. Jayson Rowicki reported that he has finished his classes and passed. Great job! He also reported that NOCO has started their tank project and Town cleanup is underway with most complying.

JUDGES REPORT: A motion was made by Ryan Lepp and seconded by Bruce Hendricks to accept the Judges report. None opposed.

DCO REPORT: A motion was made by Ryan Lepp and seconded by Matt West to accept the DCO report. None opposed.

HIGHWAY REPORT:

*A motion was made by Bruce Hendricks and seconded by Matt West to purchase a Grasshopper mower for Highway. None opposed.

*A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Ryan Lepp that Tire Days will be combined with Junk Days. Tires will have a separate section and for residential only. Price will be determined. None opposed.

*Ken is going to email Randy at EWE asking for a time frame for temporary road repairs this summer. He will explain to them what we need done to fix the roads right.

*Out of the Brush and Weeds fund the Highway guys will be cutting down trees on Aldrich and Milestrip.

*Ken gave paper to Bruce Hendricks on the ballpark walk way trail. Brenda Hendricks asked if they could add 1/8 of a mile to the total trail so it would include the Gazebo Park.

*Ken still has a lot of black top to finish. This will include upper Southside Avenue, Kent and Wiley Streets.

*William Young asked Ken Chase to look at the siding on the outside of the Town Hall before winter.

*An American Flag was donated to Highway Department from the Community Association.

WATER/SEWER REPORT: Permit to Modify was published in the Jamestown Post Journal. Form will need signed and returned back to the State.

Rick Young will fix the water spicket at the Town Hall.

NEW BUSINESS:

* Rick Young will get No Smoking signs to put up at the ballpark. It was suggested to have the Bands announce No Smoking before the concerts start.

*William Young will check with Dana regarding a "Smoke Free Environment on any Town owned properties.

*William Young has Wilmington Report.

*William Young gave a wind project update. He stated the project is on schedule for August and September. Jim Abbey asked when the monies would be coming our way? William Young will try to find this out.

*NYS Stimulus AFRA—William Young applied for this with the help of Ryan Lepp. Not for sure how much. Half will be this summer and the other half in 2022.

*Culvert work is going to be done on Rt. 83 between Pinner Road and Hunt Road.

*William Young will call Dana regarding Solar Farm Panel Law.

OLD BUSINESS:

*Ryan reported on the Security Systems that the Town needs to budget and have specs for them.

*Next month William Young would like to start working on the Budget process.

*Ryan Lepp reported on the PATCH program regarding Microsoft hacking. He stated this PATCH isn't very effective. Rick Young needs to purchase his new laptop, so he will be running Windows 10.

*William Young needs to sign the Conflict of Interest that needs to be posted after approval of the Board. A motion was made by Ryan Lepp and seconded by Matt West approving this. None opposed.

*A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Ryan Lepp to follow through with the BAN. After an extensive report from Bill reporting on what a BAN (Bridge loan) really entails.

*Jim Abbey reported on the status of Dr. Lee's building. A walk through was had to get ideas on any updates for the building. Jim Abbey will keep the Board updated on the status.

*William Young reported that the Historical Grant for the Library is finished. Next part of the grant electrical work at cemetery. There also has been monies allotted for new signs out in front of the Town Hall.

* Ryan Lepp asked if the Court house uses the same Spectrum at the Town Hall?

*William Young will set up a meeting with Ryan Lepp, Mia Abbey and himself regarding water bill increase.

*Brenda Hendricks reported that a couple boards need replaced on the Grandstand.

*Brenda Hendricks stated that the Community Association has very few members. If they don't get more volunteers, there won't be a celebration next year. It was suggested that only fireworks for next year.

*A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Bruce Hendricks approving the following budget transfers--\$300 from A1990.4 to A1910.4 and \$2,500 from A1990.4 to A8810.4. Also, a budget modification to increase DA5130.2 in the amount of \$89,716.00. None opposed.

A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Matt West to go into Executive Session at 8:30 p.m..

Out of Executive Session at 8:45 p.m.

A motion to adjourn at 8:47 by Jim Abbey and seconded by Bruce Hendricks, all in favor, none opposed.
