REGULAR MEETING TOWN BOARD OF CHERRY CREEK

LOCATION: TOWN HALL, 6845 MAIN STREET, CHERRY CREEK, NY

William Young brought the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Hearing opened at 7:00. Local Laws #1—Cannibus Dispensary and Local Law #2—Usage of Sidewalks. 3 Yes 0 No All in favor to pass #1 and #2 Local Laws, none opposed.

Motion by Bruce Hendricks, seconded by Ryan Lepp, all in favor to accept September 13, 2021 minutes.

SUPERVISOR/TREASURERS REPORT: Motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded Bruce Hendricks, all in favor to accept Supervisor/Treasurers Report, none opposed.

CLERKS REPORT: Motion was made by Bruce Hendricks and seconded by Matt West, all in favor to accept Clerks Report, none opposed.

GENERAL BILLS: #273-#305 totaling \$15,528.77 motion was made by Matt West and seconded by Jim Abbey, all in favor to pay General Bills, none opposed.

HIGHWAY BILLS: #121-#133 totaling \$103,490.63 a motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Bruce Hendricks, all in favor to pay Highway bills, none opposed.

WATER BILLS: #63-#71 totaling \$2,482.93 **SEWER BILLS:** #44-#50 TOTALING \$1,225.91, motion was made by Matt West and seconded by Bruce Hendricks, all in favor to pay Water/Sewer bills, none opposed.

SEWER BAN:

CODE/ASSESSORS REPORT: Motion was made by Bruce Hendricks and seconded by Jim Abbey to accept the Code and Assessor Report. A total of 4 permits were issued totaling \$220.00. Jayson Rowicki had an Open Forum regarding a Camper Law in Cherry Creek. A motion was made by Jim Abbey and 2nd by Matt West. All in favor, none opposed.

JUDGES REPORT: A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Bruce Hendricks to accept the Judges report. None opposed.

DCO REPORT: A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Matt West to accept the DCO report. None opposed.

HIGHWAY REPORT:

* Junk days are scheduled for October 15th 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and October 16th 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Car tires will be accepted for residents paying \$5.00 for each tire.

*Dr. Lee's building is finished.

*Meyer Tree Service is asking to use Prospect Street to drop off brush. Village opted out of this years ago. All Board members were in agreement this is only for Town/Hamlet residents.

*Black top is finished on all roads except Kent Street.

*Driveway aprons have been installed on all access roads.

*Ken thanked Ellington, Gerry, Charlotte, Villanova, Arkwright, French Creek and Suit Kote for all their help getting Cherry Creek roads skid paved and sealed before winter. There will be more work to follow. This is only temporary to get the roads ready for winter. Wind Project will pay when completed and Ken submits the invoice.

WATER/SEWER REPORT: Rick reported Cherry Creek is part owners of a VAC truck stored in Westfield. It works well for washing out DI's. A soil sample was taken last week for Sewer Project.

NEW BUSINESS:

* A class on line is being mandated for all employees regarding Workplace Violence. Rick Young is going to check if there are two different classes.

*Supervisor Young and Rick Young had a meeting with Catherine Reese regarding proper paperwork that needs to be filled out for Sewer Project.

*Per Supervisor Young CHRIC Grant has been approved. Eileen Powers will be sending paperwork to residents for the next step.

*Brenda Hendricks attended the meeting and asked what the set hours will be for trick or treating on Halloween. A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Bruce Hendricks to have trick or treating hours on Halloween from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.

*Community Association would like to get hometown hero banners for Main Street. They are asking if the Town would agree to this and be responsible for putting them up for Memorial Day and Veterans Day? The Town thought this was a great idea and has agreed to putting the flags up for both days.

*A Grant has been submitted for a Memorial Day celebration held at the ball park from 12-5. This will include music, softball games, flags made out of pallets etc.

*Music in the Park will be changing to Tuesdays next summer. It will still be held at the ball park.

*Peggy Vanwormer had a lengthy discussion regarding the train station on Depot Street. She was asking if Cherry Creek would be interested in doing something like this. It has a lot of history behind it and she would hate for it to get overlooked.

*Town employees came to the meeting with a proposal for possible future employment.

*Laura would like to set up another meeting or it could be sent to you.

* A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Matt West to add \$1,000 dollars to the Budget due to the AUD fee of filing. Supervisor Young will send a copy to the Board.

*A motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Matt West to transfer \$2,000 from A8810.1 to A8810.4 in the General Fund. Transfer \$1,000 from A1990.4 to F8310.4 in the Water Fund.

OLD BUSINESS:

*Security System

*Who is responsible for the fence at the flowing well on Main Street? It has become a safety issue and kids are climbing on it. Ken Chase will call the State to find out.

*Mia Abbey has been approved to sign Town Clerk checks.

*Ryan Lepp has Rick Youngs laptop. Ryan will have it ready when we move to Dr. Lee's building.

- *Supervisor Young reported he is doing weekly webinars called Tea Time.
- *Water/Sewer letters went out. Matt West will check on the status of relevy's.
- *Spectrum and DFT trying to get better broadband for our area.
- *The Board discussed CCB's proposal and has decided to opt out of it at this time.
- *Ken Chase will get the insurance renewal to Chris Ross.
- *Supervisor Young sent the Road Law to Dana. We only have 60 days for recommendations.
- *Supervisor Young, Ryan and Ken will set up a conference call with Dana regarding the easement.
- *Jayson Rowicki will ask Chris White for a proposal regarding the Rodeo.

Motion was made by Jim Abbey and seconded by Matt West to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 p.m.
